Their findings illuminate opportunities to increase communication between high school and PSE communities on the issue of academic preparedness, transition to PSE life, and student success. Their summative report shaped a symposium this spring that integrated knowledge from members of HEQCO, the MOE, the MTCU, multiple school boards, and Laurier faculty, staff, and students in an effort to better support students in transition.</i></p>
